Das Projekt: LDH

- Sammlung von linguistischen Arbeiten, v. a. Beschreibungen seltener, 'entlegener' Sprachen
- frei zugänglich im Internet aufgefunden, kein kommerzieller Wert
- meist etwas älter (5 Jahre +)
i. d. R. im pdf-Format
- Flüchtigkeit: Webseiten der Autoren, Institutionen u. ä.

Lokale Bearbeitung der Dateien

- Speicherung auf lokalem Server
→ institutsintern zugänglich
- Aufbereitung der Dateien (automatische Texterkennung (OCR), Seitenzählung anpassen)
- Verlinkung zur Datei im Bibliothekskatalog

Anforderungen

- Nutzungsmöglichkeiten für die Wissenschaft zu verbessern
 - Volltextsuche über alle Dokumente
 - Fachspezifische Erschließung (ISO 639-3, Geocodes)
 - Stabile links für die Dokumente oder Teile davon (Persistent Identifiers)
 - Persönliche Sammlungen für einzelne oder Arbeitsgruppen
 - abgestufte Zugangsrechte, Rechteklärung

- Verwaltung der Daten und Dokumente im institutional repository: [PubMan](#)
- Zusatzfunktionen entwickeln
- Workflows auch für andere MPDs oder Bibliotheken nützlich

Vorteile

- Vorteile für die Autoren
 - Sichtbarkeit der Arbeiten erhöhen
 - Langfristige Zugänglichkeit in einem fachspezifischen Kontext
 - Langzeitarchivierung

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The **goal** of the Language Description Heritage (LDH) Open Access Digital Library is to provide easy access to descriptive material about the world's languages. This collection is being compiled at the **Max Planck Society** in Germany as an open access digital repository of existing scientific contribution describing the world-wide linguistic diversity, focussing on traditionally difficult to obtain works.

Contributing your work to the Language Description Heritage (LDH) library will benefit you in several ways:

- It will enhance the visibility of your research so other researchers will more easily find it, acknowledge it and cite it.
- It will ensure long-term accessibility of your work through a stable URL.
- Your work will be citeable through a persistent identifier.

What is PubMan?

Main Functionalities of PubMan
