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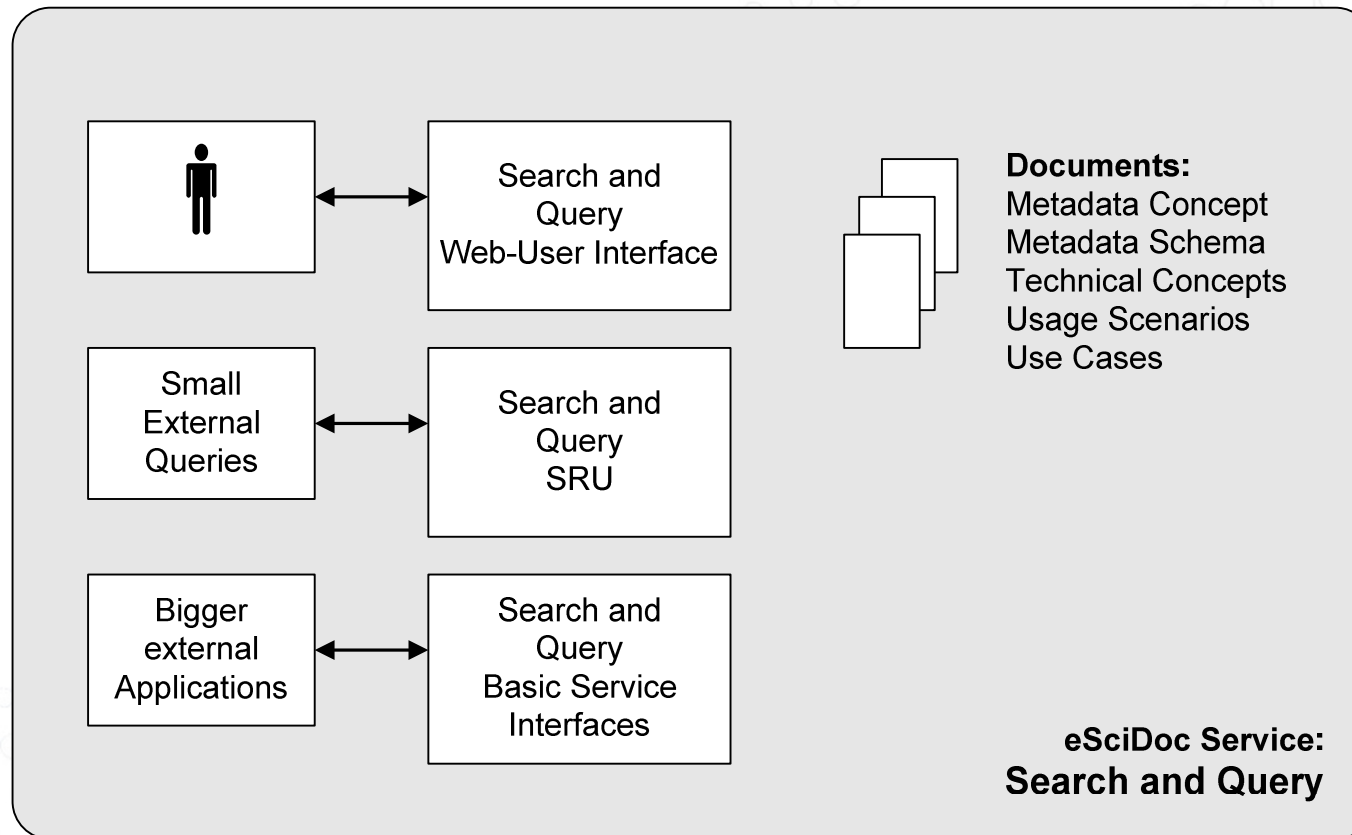

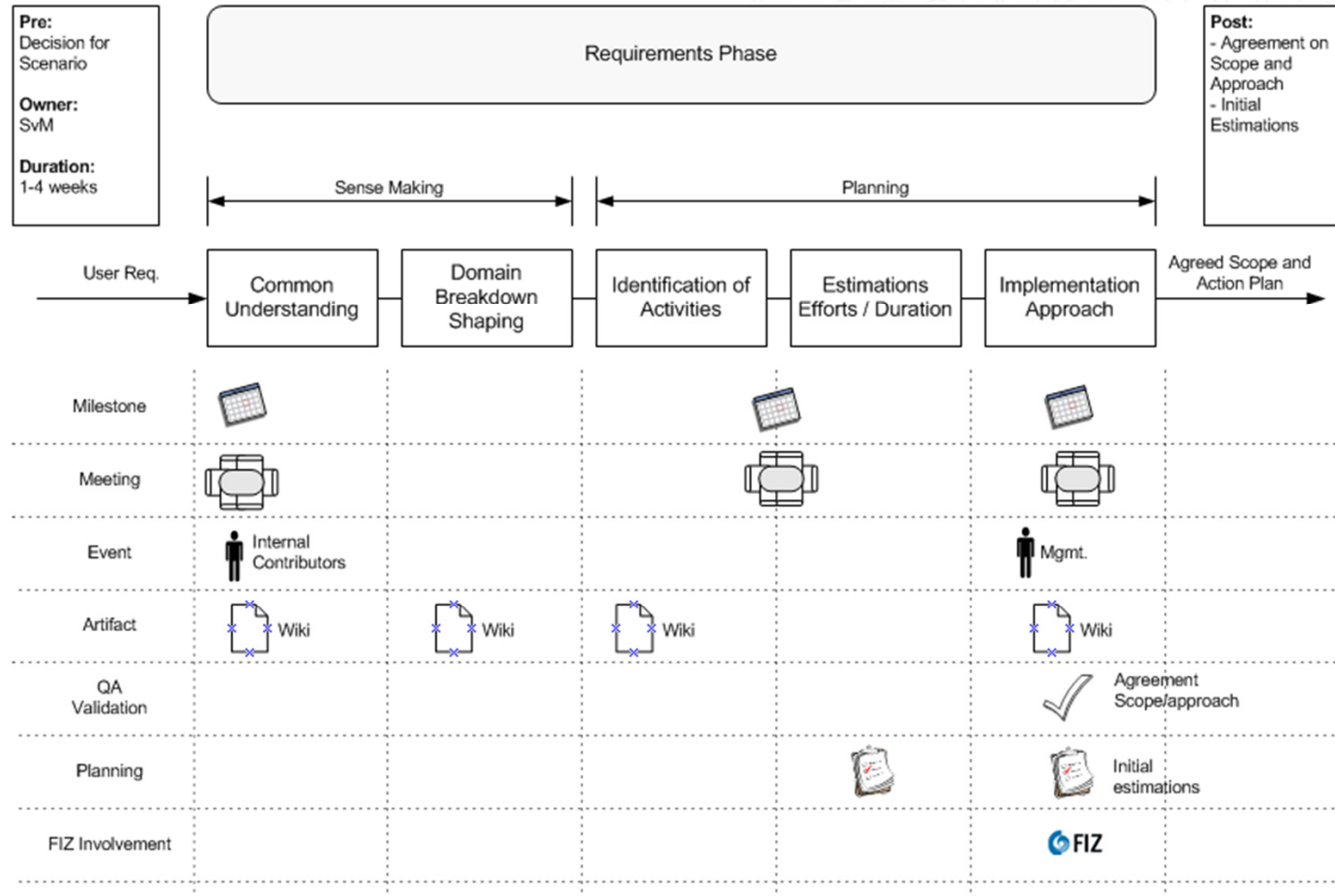

Reinhold von Sengbusch

On this website you find the publications of Prof. Dr. Reinhold von Sengbusch. Reinhold Oskar Kurt von Sengbusch (* 16 February 1898 in Riga; † 13 June 1985 in Hamburg) was a Director at the Max Planck Institut für Kulturpflanzenzüchtung in Hamburg-Volksdorf and one of the most important breeding researchers of the last century. In addition to many of his publications you can find out more about his [favorite topic](#), his [breeding achievements](#) and the [scientific impact](#) he had.

Reinhold von Sengbusch began to publish in 1924 and continued until the nineteen-eighties. Sengbusch alone and together with his colleagues published about 300 scientific articles. His institute produced about 600 publications. Over time the fulltext availability on this site will increase.
